Thank you for considering Keystone Krawlers, **Pages 1 to 3** of this form are to be kept for your own records. This is for you to get acquainted with our club principles, rules and requirements. We have created Keystone Krawlers to be a family off road club for all makes of 4x4 vehicles - To join, you may be a resident of any state. We just ask that you keep in mind that we are a South Central Pennsylvania based off-road club and many of our events take place throughout Pennsylvania and the region.

The following items are for *your safety and the safety of others* that will be involved with club-sponsored activities. We believe these are not unreasonable and we ask that all members please follow them. We also believe in the education of our sport to other members, the media, and our communities. Keystone club is about representing a safe and responsible way of off-roading. We expect *everyone* to represent our club and the hobby in a positive way.

Pages 4 and 5 of this form need to be completed and sent to the address outlined in the Membership section to complete your membership. Your signature *will be required* for the Rules and Regulations *and* the Liability Waiver. The waiver states that in the case of any trail incidents that Keystone Krawlers will not be held responsible for any vehicle damage, personal damage, stolen or lost property in any way or form. All activities are on a voluntary basis and are on a first come; first serve priority.

Members will be subject to regular emails detailing events and planning activities. If you are not equipped with e-mail capabilities, events and activities can be mailed to you directly or you may be contacted by phone. Please see below on the form for our current membership fees.

Why the membership fee? This helps the club cover overhead costs associated with web hosting, membership cards, and helps us provide our members with better activities. Since Keystone Krawlers was established with a charter member base of about 20 members, we have plenty of room to grow, learn, and try new ideas. *Membership and club funds will be kept within the club and used for its members.*

Keystone Krawlers Rules and Regulations:

1. Seatbelts must be worn at all times while attending a Keystone Krawlers events. Infants through children age three, must be properly restrained in an appropriate child safety seat or in accordance with state laws as they apply. Children over the age of three must wear a seatbelt at all times or in accordance with state laws as they apply.
2. Must be 18 to Join as a Club Member- Any driver, of legal driving age, but under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a legal parent or guardian for said individual- All responsibility for this driver will be that of the parent or guardian.
3. Illegal drugs/substances are not permitted at any Keystone Krawlers event. Alcohol is not permitted on the trails or at any Keystone Krawlers offroading events (driver or passengers). Anyone under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or illegal substances during offroading events will be ejected immediately. Coolers are not permitted to contain alcohol and can be searched during offroad events. During non-offroad events, alcohol is allowed in moderation and the Keystone Krawlers members reserve the right to remove anyone that is not conducting themselves appropriately.
4. Firearms and Weapons will not be permitted at Keystone Krawlers events. This is a don't ask, don't tell policy for those with legal Conceal and Carry permits for that state or states with reciprocity agreement's. If at anytime a Weapon is displayed or witnessed during the event- the person responsible for the weapon may be asked to leave.
5. All vehicles must be insured- unless specifically stated otherwise.
6. All drivers must hold a valid drivers license
7. All vehicles must have at least one tow point (example: tow hook or receiver hitch). The trail leader may require front and rear tow points. This will be communicated prior to the event.
8. All vehicles must have the following: Proper roll-over protection (Factory equipped or otherwise), Full size spare tire (or tire large enough to get you off of the trail), Battery tie-downs (no bungee cords), Seatbelts, Tow point(s), Trash bag for liquid spills, and a Tow strap (within the group), Fire Extinguisher (within the group). Pre-ride tech inspections are at the discretion of the trail guide.
9. Excessive speed will not be tolerated.
10. No tricks or horseplay at the staging area. Please do not cause a commotion or damage to other vehicles
11. Please respect proper trail etiquette. If you are unsure what this means, contact the trail leader
12. All participants must stay on designated trails. Keystone Krawlers abide by the Tread Lightly etiquette. Do not blaze a trail.
13. No disorderly conduct; No littering; this includes tobacco products. (Cigarette Butts, Cigars, etc...). It is of the recommendation of the Keystone Krawlers that no glass bottles be brought onto the trail, plastic is preferred do to the fragility of glass.
14. Participants must listen and respect the Trail Guide and follow the above rules at all times while in attendance of a Keystone Krawlers event.
15. It is the responsibility of each and every attendee to report behavior to the trail guide that does not coincide with the above rules. Please contact the trail guide with any questions or concerns that may arise during the event.
16. If a decision is made, by the trail guide, to remove a member or guest from the trail ride because of the inability to meet the above criteria- that member will do so, without incident or disturbance.
17. If at ANY time during an event, the trail guide feels it necessary to stop, postpone or cancel the event- He/ She has the authority to do so without repercussions. This will be done in the best interest of the group.
18. If ANYONE attending the event feels that there is an unsafe situation, use the CB channel currently being monitored to announce "All-Stop"; this will inform the trail guide and other officers that there is a situation that needs immediate attention.
19. Rules as with the laws of our great nation, are updated from time to time. Any changes will be communicated prior to the event. All members reserve the right to remind you of these outlined rules.

Tech Inspection- Points of Interest

At minimum, the following can be checked at the discretion of the Trail leader:

- Tow Points (*Minimum one. Some Rides may require front and rear.*)
- Proper Battery Tie Down (*No Bungee Cords*)
- Full Size Spare
- Jack (*Factory or otherwise*)
- Decent Tread on Tires (*AT's Ok- MT's may be required for some trail rides*)
- Other equipment may be checked at the discretion of the trail leader.

Any special requirements will be outlined before a club event.
